**RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING JUNE 6, 2015 AS AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY BARK FOR LIFE DAY IN THE CITY OF RAMSEY**

**WHEREAS**, Bark For Life is an American Cancer Society fundraising event that honors the care-giving qualities of canine companions and supports the American Cancer Society mission of saving lives and creating a world with less cancer and more birthdays – by helping people stay well, by helping people get well, by finding cures for cancer and by fighting back; and

**WHEREAS**, money raised during Bark for Life supports the American Cancer Society’s live-saving mission; and

**WHEREAS**, the last three events (Bark for Life in the City of Ramsey) have collectively raised over \$25,000 for cancer research.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA; as follows:**

- 1) That the City Council of the City of Ramsey hereby proclaims Saturday, June 6, 2015, as “Bark For Life Day” in the City of Ramsey and encourages citizens to help finish the fight against cancer by participating in the Bark For Life event at The Draw Park located within The COR on Saturday, June 6, 2015.
