Turn east at stop light intersection of 133rd Ave and Hanson Blvd. Compost site is one mile east of Hanson Blvd on 133rd Ave. Watch for directional signs at Hanson Blvd and 133rd Ave.

*** Sunset Closing Hours**

Starting at the end of September, sunset occurs before 7 p.m. The compost sites are not equipped with lights. For the safety of our workers and customers we cannot allow access to the site after sunset. Please allow at least 15 minutes before closing time to pay for and unload your yard waste.

Materials Accepted**Leaves, Grass, and Non-Woody Yard Waste**

The following materials are considered leaves, grass and other non-woody yard waste: acorns, garden waste, grass clippings, leaves, pine cones and needles, sod (residential quantities), soft-bodied green plants, and weeds. Leaves and grass must be debagged.

Tree Waste

The following materials are considered tree waste: brush, evergreen boughs, logs, shrub trimmings, stumps. The price depends on the size and amount of the material. The loads are measured to determine the quantity that is being dropped off. Tree waste may be loose or bundled. The more compact you make your load, the lower the fee.

Organics

There is no charge for county residents to drop off organic waste. Materials accepted include food scraps, non-recyclable uncoated paper, and compostable products certified by the Biodegradable Products Institute (BPI).

*Please unload and debag all yard/tree waste and bring all bags/containers home. Even paper or other compostable bags need to be debagged and brought home. Reusable alternatives to bags that work well are plastic garbage cans or tarps.

Fees:

- **Bunker Hills Site - Accepts cash, credit and debit card payments.**
- **Rice Creek Site - Accepts cash payments only.**
- **You must show proof of residency.**

1 cubic yard = approximately 5-8 yard waste bags.

Leaves, Grass and Non-Woody Yard Waste Fees

0-4 cu yd	No Charge
5-8 cu yd	\$ 5.00
9-12 cu yd	\$ 10.00
13-16 cu yd	\$ 15.00
17-20 cu yd	\$ 20.00

Tree Waste Fees

Description	Fee
Branches/trunks/logs, 6 in. or less in diameter	\$6/cubic yard
Branches/trunks/logs, 6 -18 in. in diameter	\$10/cubic yard
Branches/trunks/logs, 18 in.+ in diameter	\$20/cubic yard
Stumps, 1-36 in. in diameter	\$40/cubic yard
Stumps, 36 in.+ in diameter	\$60/cubic yard

Description	Fee
Dirty loads, loads with materials mixed together	\$20/cubic yard
Christmas trees (decorations removed)	No Charge
Christmas wreaths	\$5.00/wreath

Compost Availability

Compost and mulch will not be available for sale December through March. April through November, when available, finished compost may be picked up on a first come, first served basis (non-commercial use only). Contact sites directly for product availability. Be sure to bring your own containers and shovel.
