RESOLUTION ACCEPTING NEW DRAINAGE AND UTILITY EASEMENTS RELATED TO AN ADMINISTRATIVE SUBDIVISION OF LOTS 7 AND 8 WINDSORWOOD

WHEREAS, Raymond Silhanek and Leslie Reed-Silhanek, hereafter referred to as “Developer”, properly applied for an Administrative Subdivision of the following described property located in the City of Ramsey:

Lot 7, Block 1 Windsorwood, Anoka County, Minnesota

AND

Lot 8, Block 1 Windsorwood, Anoka County, Minnesota

(the ‘Subject Properties’);

WHEREAS, the City of Ramsey received an application for an Administrative Subdivision from the Developer on September 15, 2017; and
