**RESOLUTION VACATING PEDESTRIAN TRAIL EASEMENT ON LOT 6, BLOCK 3, WILDLIFE SANCTUARY THIRD ADDITION**

**WHEREAS**, the property owners of Lot 6, Block 3, Wildlife Sanctuary Third Addition request the existing pedestrian trail easement on their property be vacated; and

**WHEREAS**, platted drainage and utility easements underlie the pedestrian trail easement; and

**WHEREAS**, the pedestrian trail easement provides no benefit to the general public; and

**WHEREAS**, the property owners will be responsible for all costs associated with vacating the easement.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, as follows:**
