AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL CLOSING TIMES LICENSE OF ON-SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR DURING THE 2018 NATIONAL FOOTBALL LEAGUE SUPER BOWL GAME AT U.S. BANK STADIUM

SECTION 1. AUTHORITY

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to and under the authority of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Ramsey, Section 12.06 and Minnesota Statutes 412.851.

2017 MN H.F. 1, Art. 11, §19, provides the authority for the City to issue special on-sale intoxicating liquor licenses during the 2018 National Football League Super Bowl at U.S. Bank Stadium to allow for the service of alcohol through extended hours lasting until 4:00 a.m.

SECTION 2. CONDITIONS

The following conditions shall apply to the on-sale intoxicating liquor license to allow extended hours of service of alcohol until 4:00 a.m.

- a. Only holders of an existing on-sale intoxicating liquor license or 3.2 malt liquor license issued by the City are eligible and shall only be issued upon approval of the City.
- b. The license shall only be effective during the period from 8:00 a.m., February 2, 2018 through 4:00 a.m., Monday, February 5, 2018.
- c. At 4:01 a.m., February 5, 2018, the license shall expire and terminate with no further action required by the City.
- d. The license shall be subject to the conditions, prohibited acts and penalties set forth in Minn. Stat. Chapter 340A and City Code Chapter 6.
- e. Application shall be in a form prescribed by the City with a license fee of \$100.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance becomes effective 30 days after its passage and publication, subject to City Charter Section 5.04.
