

Councilmember _____ introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

RESOLUTION #18-091

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SPEED STUDY REQUEST FOR BUNKER LAKE BOULEVARD/CSAH 116 BETWEEN ARMSTRONG BOULEVARD/CSAH 83 AND SUNFISH LAKE BOULEVARD/CSAH 57

WHEREAS, the existing posted speed limit on Bunker Lake Boulevard/CSAH 116 between Armstrong Boulevard/CSAH 83 and Sunfish Lake Boulevard/CSAH 57 is 55 mph; and

WHEREAS, the owner of a residential development north of Bunker Lake Boulevard between Zeolite Street and Town Center Drive is concerned that the posted speed limit of 55 mph on said road segment presents a dangerous situation for residents of area developments; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute 169.14 allows local road authorities to pass a resolution requesting a speed study investigation by MnDOT; and

WHEREAS, the local road authority that owns and operates the road segment to be studied is responsible to submit the speed study request to MNDOT; and

WHEREAS, Bunker Lake Boulevard/CSAH 116 is owned and operated by Anoka County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA:

That the Ramsey City Council hereby authorizes the City Engineer to submit a request to Anoka County for the Minnesota Department of Transportation to complete a speed study on Bunker Lake Boulevard/CSAH 116 between Armstrong Boulevard/CSAH 83 and Sunfish Lake Boulevard/CSAH 57.
