

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Ramsey City Council will hold a public hearing at 7:00 pm on Tuesday November 13, 2018 in the Ramsey Municipal Center Council Chambers, 7550 Sunwood Drive NW, Ramsey MN. The purpose of the hearing is to consider Improvement Project #19-02 which proposes grading, bituminous pavement reclamation and paving, drainage, and miscellaneous appurtenant improvements to 173rd Avenue from Germanium Street to its termini cul-de-sac, and Germanium Street from 170th Lane to its termini cul-de-sac.

Properties abutting the improved streets are proposed to be assessed per Minnesota Statutes, Sections 429.011 to 429.111, Chapter 8 of the Ramsey City Charter, and the City's adopted Special Assessments Policy. The total estimated cost of the above described project is \$502,555.46. A reasonable estimate of the impact of the assessment, preliminarily proposed at \$4,418.30 per benefitting property to be assessed over ten years with interest at two-percent above the bond interest rate, will be available at the hearing.

Written comments are welcome and shall be addressed to the Ramsey City Council, 7550 Sunwood Drive NW, Ramsey, MN 55303. Written comments will be received at the above address until 4:30 pm on November 13, 2018. All interested persons are invited to attend the hearing and comment on the proposed improvement project.
