**Purpose/Background:**

Community Development Director Tim Gladhill will provide a mid-academic year update on RCP. In 2017, the City was selected as this year's Community Partner for the University of Minnesota's Resilient Communities Project (RCP). RCP matches community projects with resources at the University of Minnesota to complete a wide variety of topics.
