

Councilmember _____ introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

RESOLUTION #19-236

RESOLUTION ADOPTING ASSESSMENT ROLL CERTIFYING ASSESSMENTS FOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT #19-01, FORD BROOK ESTATES STREET RECONSTRUCTIONS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council Resolution #18-175, adopted August 28, 2018, a Feasibility Report was prepared by the City Engineer with reference to proposed improvements to approximately 0.16 miles of streets within the Ford Brook Estates development including 180th Lane from Highway 47/Saint Francis Boulevard to Krypton Street, and Krypton Street from 180th Lane to its termini cul-de-sac, including the reconstruction of streets and other appurtenant work; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council Resolution #18-219, adopted October 23, 2018, the Feasibility Report was received and accepted, and a Public Hearing was ordered for November 13, 2018 at 7 p.m., where the City Council will consider the proposed improvements for said streets in accordance with the Feasibility Report; and

WHEREAS, benefiting properties are proposed to be assessed up to 25-percent of the cost of the improvements, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Chapter 429, Chapter 8 of the City Charter, and the City's Special Assessments Policy; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk gave mailed and published notice of such hearing and improvements as required by law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council Resolution #18-229, adopted November 13, 2018, the City Council conducted a Public Hearing, approved the Feasibility Report, and ordered the City Engineer to prepare plans and specifications for the making of such improvements; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council Resolution #19-079, adopted March 26, 2019, the City Council accepted final plans and specifications and authorized advertisements for bids for said improvements; and

WHEREAS, bids were advertised in the Anoka Union Herald and in Finance and Commerce on March 29 and April 5, 2019; and

WHEREAS, bids were received, opened, and tabulated on May 1, 2019, and the following bids were found to comply with the advertisement for bids; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council Resolution #19-113, adopted May 14, 2019, the bid of Asphalt Surface Technologies of Saint Cloud, Minnesota, in the amount of \$262,503.25 for the total bid for construction of the base bid improvements plus the alternate bid improvements was accepted and a contract was let for said improvements; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council Resolution #19-217, adopted September 10, 2019, an assessment roll was ordered and an assessment hearing was called for October 8, 2019 for said improvements; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice duly given as required by law, the Council met, heard and passed upon all objections to the proposed assessment for the reconstruction of streets within the Ford Brook Estates residential development including 180th Lane from Highway 47/Saint Francis Boulevard to Krypton Street, and Krypton Street from 180th Lane to its termini cul-de-sac, along with miscellaneous appurtenant improvements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, as follows:

- 1) Such proposed assessment, a copy of which is attached and incorporated herein, is hereby accepted and constitutes the special assessment against the listed properties. Each listed property is hereby found to be benefited by the proposed improvement in the amount of the assessment levied against it.
- 2) Such assessment shall be payable in equal annual installments extending over a period of 10 years, and shall bear interest at the rate of 3.90 percent per annum from the date of the adoption of this assessment resolution. To the first installment shall be added interest on the entire assessment from the date of this assessment resolution until December 31, 2020. To each subsequent installment when due shall be added interest for 1 year on all unpaid installments.
- 3) The owner of any property so assessed may, at any time prior to certification of the assessment to the County Auditor, pay the whole of the assessment on such property, with interest accrued to the date of payment, to the City Finance Office, except that no interest shall be charged if the entire assessment is paid before November 15, 2019. Such payment must be made by November 15 or interest will be charged through December 31 of the succeeding year. In subsequent years, the property owner may at any time pay to the City the balance of the assessment remaining unpaid after the current year, provided such payment is made before November 15.

- 4) The City Clerk shall transmit a certification of this assessment to the Anoka County Auditor's Office to be extended on the property tax lists of the County. Such assessments shall be collected and paid in the same manner as other municipal taxes.
