RESOLUTION #20-186

RESOLUTION TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING OFF-PREMISE ADVERTISING RESTRICTION ON DYNAMIC DISPLAY SIGNS

WHEREAS, the current COVID-19 Pandemic has had a negative economic impact to our local businesses; and

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota continues to be in a Peacetime State of Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ramsey has made several previous adjustments to rules, regulations and financial assistance programs aimed at assisting our local business community.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, as follows:

- 1) That the City Council of the City of Ramsey hereby temporarily suspends enforcement of the restriction on off-premise advertising on dynamic display signs.
- 2) That this temporary suspension of enforcement will automatically expire upon lifting of the State of Minnesota Peacetime Emergency Declaration.
- 3) That any dynamic display sign owner is responsible for obtaining a Temporary Sign Permit for purposes of this exemption and is responsible for acquiring any other applicable permit including, but not limited to the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT).

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was duly seconded by Councilmember , and upon vote being taken thereon, the following voted in favor thereof:
