RESOLUTION ACCEPTING MUNICIPAL UTILITY TESTING PROPOSALS FOR 2021 PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM PROJECTS

WHEREAS, televising of sanitary and storm sewers and leak testing of watermain is required to accurately evaluate the condition of below ground municipal utilities within proposed 2021 pavement management program projects; and

WHEREAS, request for proposals were submitted to three firms for the purpose of obtaining quotes for competing the proposed televising services; and

WHEREAS, the two televising quotes received are tabulated below; and

WHEREAS, request for proposals were submitted to two firms for the purpose of obtaining quotes for completing the proposed watermain leak testing services; and

WHEREAS, the one leak testing quote received is tabulated below; and
