RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BIDS AND AWARDING CONTRACT FOR 2021 MSA PAVEMENT OVERLAY IMPROVEMENTS, IMPROVEMENT PROJECT #21-05

WHEREAS, the City of Ramsey proposes to overlay the pavement on numerous Municipal State Aid (MSA) street segments in 2021 as identified within the 2021 – 2030 Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, funding for this improvement is proposed to come from the MSA Fund and Stormwater Utility Fund with a total estimated project cost of \$295,000; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Staff resolution #21-012, adopted January 12, 2021, the City Engineer has prepared plans and specifications for the purpose of advertising for bids for the same improvements.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council resolution #21-075, adopted March 23, 2021, the City Council approved final plans and specifications as prepared by the City Engineer and authorized advertisement for bids for said improvements; and

WHEREAS, eight (8) bids were received, opened, and tabulated on April 19, 2021, and the following bids were found to comply with the approved plans and specifications and advertisements for bids; and
