**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PROPOSED 2021, PAYABLE 2022 TAX LEVY AND SCHEDULE BUDGET PUBLIC MEETING DATE**

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, COUNTY OF ANOKA, STATE OF MINNESOTA, as follows:**

- 1) That the following proposed levies for certified 2021, payable 2022, be levied upon the taxable property in said City of Ramsey, Anoka County, State of Minnesota for the following purposes:

**TOTAL PROPOSED LEVIES**

**\$ 15,321,278**

- 1) That the City of Ramsey will not be levying the \$334,139 related to the \$3,090,000 GO Refunding Bond, Series 2011B, as per Joint Powers Agreement with Anoka County. Anoka County is required to pay directly to the City, this debt service amount.
- 2) That the City of Ramsey will not be levying the \$1,259,173 (105% of debt service) related to the 2012 GO Capital Improvement Plan Refunding Bonds for the Municipal Center. The City will levy at \$796,698 for the new 2021 GO Capital Improvement Plan Refunding Bonds for the Municipal Center (refunding the 2012 GO CIP Issue) that will be sold on September 28, 2021.

- 3) That the City of Ramsey's 2021 Public Budget Meeting for 2022 Payable is scheduled for Tuesday, December 14, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.
- 6) That the Finance Director be directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Anoka County Auditor's Office on or before Thursday, September 30, 2021.
