RESOLUTION #22-021

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BIDS AND AWARDING CONTRACT FOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT #21-10, FIRE STATION No.1 PARKING LOT IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the City proposes to overlay the pavement and improve drainage of the Fire Station No. 1 Parking Lot; and

WHEREAS, the City staff has the capacity to prepare plans and specifications for improvement project #21-10, Fire Station No.1 Parking Lot Improvements; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council resolution #21-195, adopted July 27, 2021, the City Engineer has prepared plans and specifications for the purpose of advertising for bids for the same improvements.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council resolution #21-344, adopted December 14, 2021, the City Council approved final plans and specifications as prepared by the City Engineer and authorized advertisement for bids for said improvements; and

WHEREAS, Eleven (11) bids were received, opened, and tabulated on January 18, 2022, and the following bids were found to comply with the advertisement for bids; and
