**RESOLUTION #22-034**

**RESOLUTION AKNOWLEDGING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PLAYGROUND REPLACEMENT POLICY, AND DECLARING THE OBSOLETE PARK PLAY EQUIPMENT AT AUTUMN HEIGHTS AND SHAWN ACRES PARKS, SURPLUS PROPERTY FOR REMOVAL**

**WHEREAS**, the play equipment at Autumn Heights and Shawn Acres Park’s is several decades old, is no longer used by children and the Playground Replacement Policy calls for their removals, without replacement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Park and Recreation Commission acknowledged the two playground removals at the regular January meeting, and also directed Staff to mail an invitation to 89 neighbors of Rabbit Park to ascertain their desires for the removal, and potential replacement of the play equipment there; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA:**

That, the existing play equipment within Autumn Heights and Shawn Acres Parks be declared surplus property and that staff is hereby directed to dispose of it in the most fiscally responsible manner possible.
