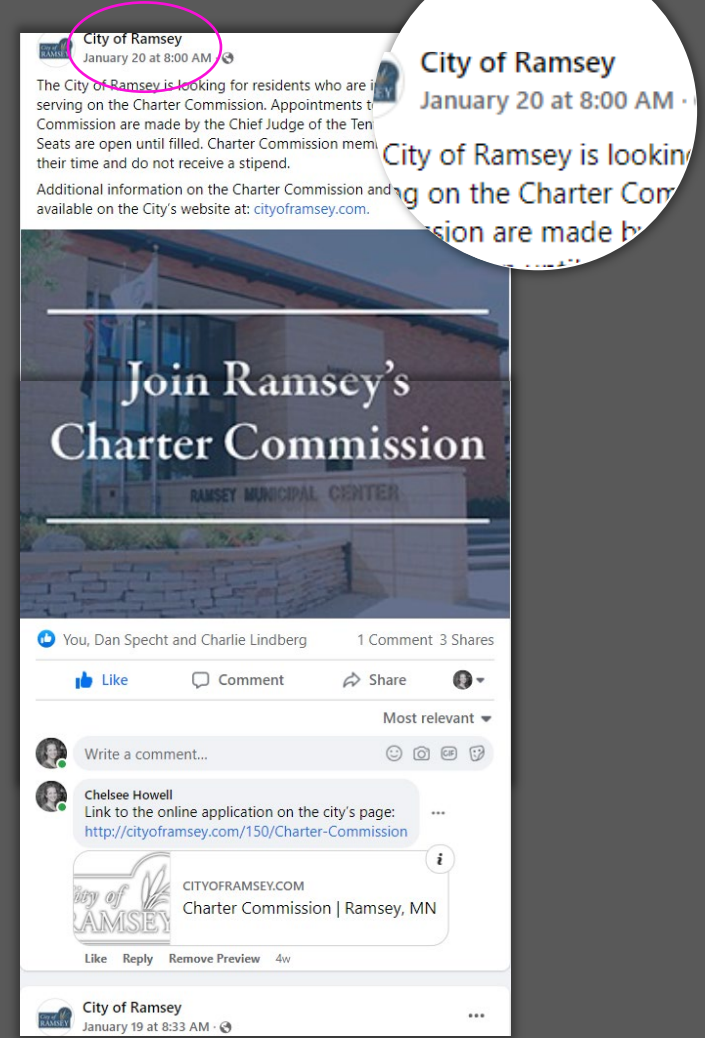

Charter Commission ad Posted Jan. 10 then pulled.
Applications were only accepted thru Jan. 21

States that the purpose of an advisory commission is to make specific recommendations to the City Council on current issues facing the City. States that advisory commission seats are open until filled and the first review of applications is scheduled for February 18, 2022. States that Facebook job applications will not be accepted and that applicants should follow the instructions above to ensure their application reaches the Human Resources team.

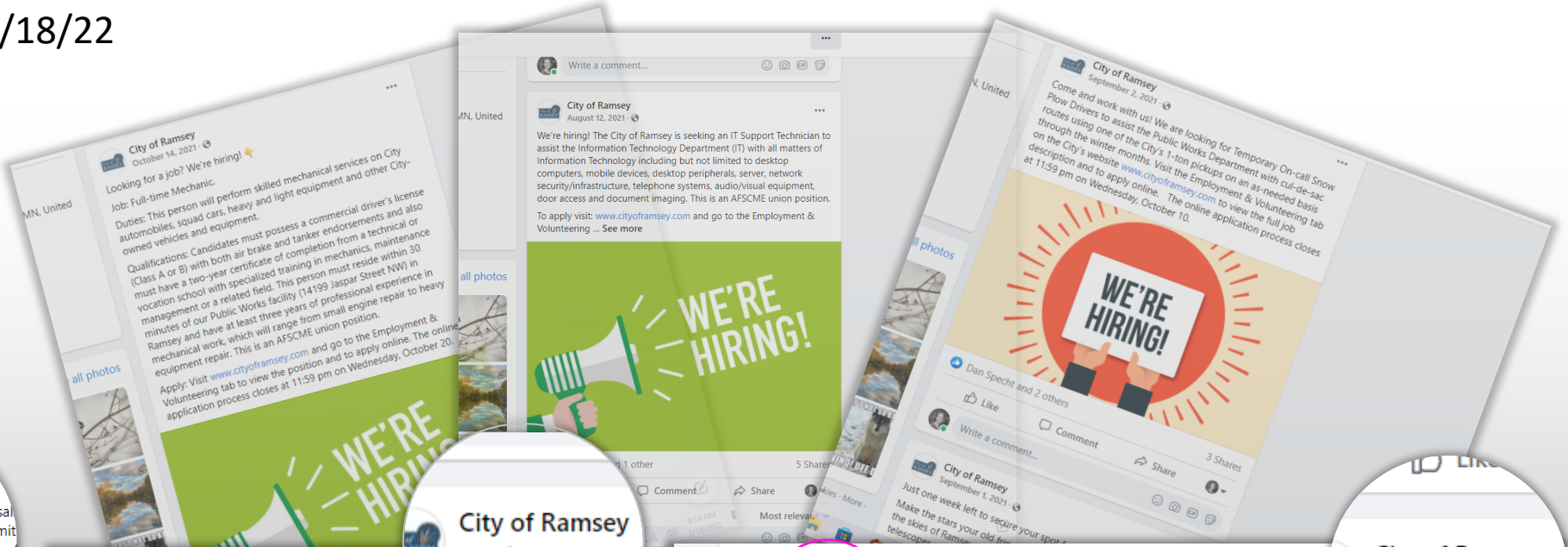

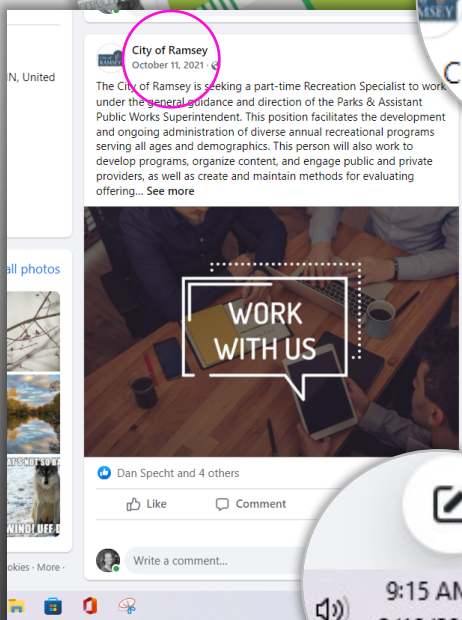

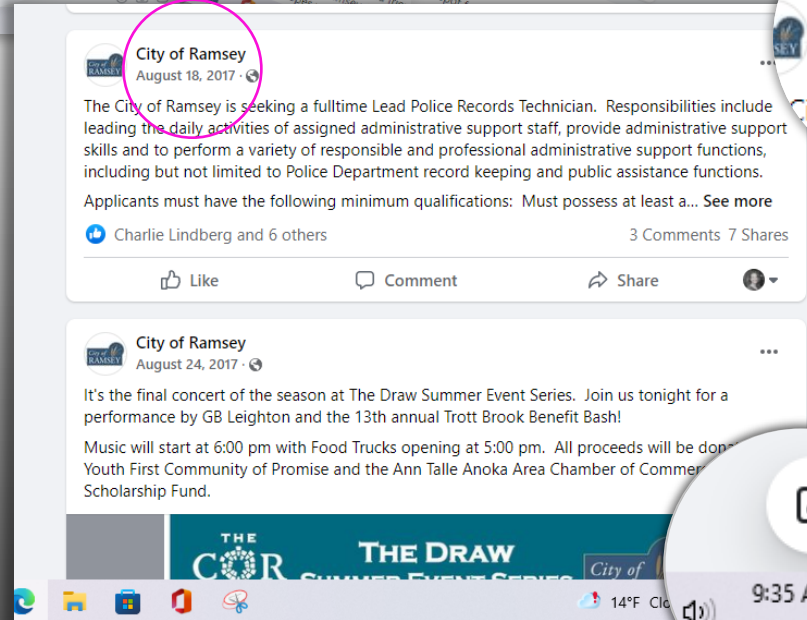
