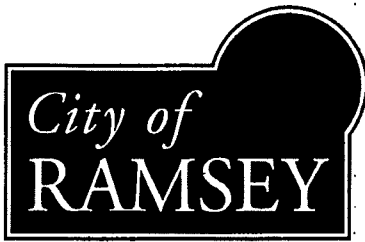

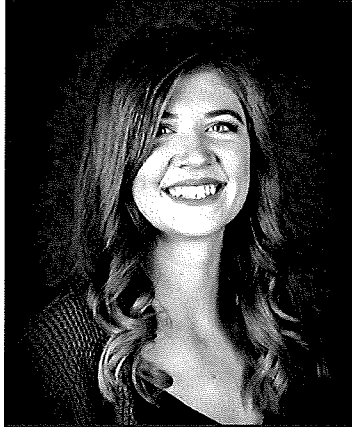
Employee Spotlight

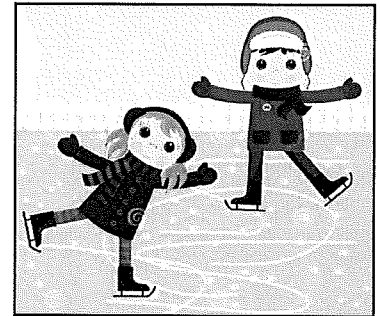
