

Councilmember _____ introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

RESOLUTION #22-163

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FINAL PAYMENT TO NORTH VALLEY, INC., FOR FIRE STATION NO. 1, PARKING LOT IMPROVEMENTS, IMPROVEMENT PROJECT #21-10

WHEREAS, the City proposes to overlay the pavement and improve drainage of the Fire Station No. 1 Parking Lot Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City staff has the capacity to prepare plans and specifications for said improvements; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council resolution #21-195, adopted July 27, 2021, the City Engineer has prepared plans and specifications for the purpose of advertising for bids for said improvements.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council resolution #21-344, adopted December 14, 2021, the City Council approved final plans and specifications as prepared by the City Engineer and authorized advertisement for bids for said improvements; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council resolution #22-021, adopted January 25, 2022, the City Council authorized entering into a construction contract with North Valley Inc. for the making of such improvements at the contract price of \$104,935.73; and

WHEREAS, as of July 26, 2022 \$117,987.61 has been paid to date; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer Technician IV has inspected the completed work and recommends final payment to North Valley Inc., of Nowthen Minnesota, for Fire Station No. 1 Parking Lot Improvements, Improvement Project #21-10, in the amount of \$8,180.56.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, as follows:

- 1) That the City Council hereby authorizes final payment to North Valley, Inc., of Nowthen Minnesota, for Improvement Project #21-10, Fire Station No. 1 Parking Lot Improvements, in the amount of \$8,180.56.
- 2) The City Council hereby accepts the project and authorizes the Mayor or City Administrator to sign and release form for this payment.
- 3) The total amount of this payment is not included in resolutions approving payment of bills for the date of July 26, 2022.
- 4) That the City of Ramsey Finance Department will be provided a signed copy of this resolution.
