RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF ANOKA COUNTY OWNED HIGHWAY PROPERTIES FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT TRAINING

WHEREAS, Anoka County is the owner of certain buildings located on Highway 10 at Ramsey Blvd. and Highway 10 at Sunfish Lake Blvd., in the city of Ramsey, Minnesota, which are more specifically described in Exhibit A attached hereto (the “Highway Properties”); and,

WHEREAS, User desires to use the Highway Properties for its Fire Department exercise training, not to include any live burn training; and

WHEREAS, the Owner has agreed to allow the User to use the Highway Properties at a cost of \$0.00, pursuant to the terms and conditions in this agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA
