NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, COUNTY OF ANOKA, STATE OF MINNESOTA, as follows:

- 1) That the following proposed levies for certified 2023, payable 2024, be levied upon the taxable property in said City of Ramsey, Anoka County, State of Minnesota for the following purposes:

- 1) That the City of Ramsey will not be levying the \$334,289 related to the \$3,090,000 GO Refunding Bond, Series 2011B, as per Joint Powers Agreement with Anoka County. Anoka County is required to pay directly to the City, this debt service amount.
- 2) That the City of Ramsey will not be levying the \$1,179,098 (105% of debt service) related to the 2021 GO Capital Improvement Plan Refunding Bonds for the Municipal Center. Levy amount will be as stated above.

- 3) That the City of Ramsey's 2023 Public Budget Meeting for 2024 Payable is scheduled for Tuesday, December 12, 2023 at 7:00 p.m.
- 4) That the Finance Director be directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Anoka County Auditor's Office on or before Monday, October 2, 2023.
