**RESOLUTION #24-213**

**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BIDS AND AWARDING CONTRACT FOR 2024 MSA PAVEMENT OVERLAY IMPROVEMENTS, IMPROVEMENT PROJECT #24-06**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Ramsey proposes to overlay the pavement on numerous Municipal State Aid (MSA) street segments in 2024 as identified within the 2024 – 2033 Capital Improvement Program; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ramsey City Council Resolution #23-298, adopted November 28, 2023, the City Council ordered the City Engineer to prepare plans and specifications for 2024 MSA Pavement Overlay Improvements, Improvement Project #24-06; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ramsey City Council Resolution #24-178, adopted July 9, 2024, the City Council approved final plans and specifications as prepared by the City Engineer and authorized advertisement for bids for said improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, bids were advertised in the Anoka Union Herald on Friday, July 12 and July 19, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, six (6) bids were received, opened and tabulated on August 5, 2024, and the following bids were found to comply with the approved plans and specifications and advertisement for bids; and
