MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between the Ramsey Police Department and Anoka County Emergency Communications Center Regarding Access to Evidence.com Credentials for Axon–RapidSOS Integration

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into by and between the **Ramsey Police Department** (hereinafter referred to as the “Agency”) and **Anoka County Emergency Communications Center** (hereinafter referred to as “ACECC”) for the purpose of authorizing ACECC to access the Agency’s Evidence.com credentials to enable the integration of **Axon Mobile Responder** with **RapidSOS**.

1. Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to establish a mutual understanding and agreement that allows ACECC to securely access and utilize the Agency’s Evidence.com API credentials to enable real-time location sharing and device metadata visibility through RapidSOS for enhanced emergency response coordination.

2. Scope

This agreement authorizes ACECC to:

- Use the Agency’s Evidence.com API Client credentials (Client ID, Secret, Partner ID, and Domain) solely for the purpose of enabling Axon Mobile Responder integration with RapidSOS.
- View and utilize location and device metadata of the Agency’s personnel and equipment during emergency response situations.
- Broadcast via radio or mobile data terminal responder location data during emergency response situations.
- Share this data with authorized personnel within ACECC and RapidSOS for operational purposes.

3. Responsibilities

Anoka County Emergency Communications Center agrees to:

- Maintain the confidentiality and security of all credentials and data accessed.
- Use the credentials exclusively for the purposes outlined in this MOU.
- Immediately notify the Agency of any suspected misuse or breach of data.

Anoka County Emergency Communications ▲ Respectful, Innovative, Fiscally Responsible.

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The Ramsey Police Department agrees to:

- Provide the necessary API credentials to ACECC in a secure manner.
- Notify ACECC of any changes to credentials or access permissions.
- Retain the right to revoke access at any time by disabling or deleting the API Client.
- Data stays with the law enforcement agency for the purposes of the Minnesota Data Practices Act. The law enforcement agency is responsible for maintaining and releasing the data.

4. Data Security and Compliance

Both parties agree to comply with all applicable local, state, and federal laws regarding data privacy, security, and the use of law enforcement technology. All data shared under this MOU will be handled in accordance with Axon and RapidSOS security protocols.

5. Term and Termination

This MOU shall remain in effect until terminated by either party with written notice. Either party may terminate this agreement at any time, with or without cause, by providing written notice to the other party.
