### **RE: Notice of Hearing for Violation of Tobacco License**

Dear Grant Rademacher,

Cherokee Liquors, Inc. currently holds a 2025 tobacco license #13436 issued by the City of Ramsey ("City") pursuant to City Code Article XVI Tobacco. The following violation of the terms and conditions of your license, specifically a violation of City Code § 26-753(1), is alleged to have occurred at G-Will Liquors, located at 5427 Alpine Dr NW, Ramsey, MN 55303, on the following date:

November 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025:

- Failed a tobacco compliance check conducted by the Ramsey Police Department, namely, a male under the age of 21 entered the store and attempted to purchase a tobacco product from the clerk David Williams. David requested identification, which was provided, showing that the person was under 21 years of age; the sale was then made for a tin of Copenhagen Wintergreen Long Cut costing \$10.69 at 12:12 hours. The Officer monitoring the sale spoke with David, and issued him a citation.

Additional information regarding this violation can be found in the attached Compliance Check Form. Based on this alleged violation of your tobacco license and City Code § 26-752 and Minn. Stat. § 461.12, subd. 2. you are hereby notified that the City will proceed with a hearing regarding the violation and related monetary fine on Tuesday, January 13, 2026, at 7:00 pm at the Ramsey City Council meeting held in the Council Chambers located at City Hall, 7550 Sunwood Drive NW, Ramsey, MN 55303.

At the hearing, you may be represented by counsel or a person of your choosing and shall be given the opportunity to be heard and present evidence. If the City Council finds that a violation of your tobacco license has occurred pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 461.12, subd. 2, the penalty is a \$300 fine.
