

Councilmember introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

RESOLUTION #26-041

RESOLUTION APPROVING FINAL PAYMENT TO KURILLA CONTRACTING FOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT #24-54; THE WATERFRONT TRAIL IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Ramsey Proposes to construct trail construction project that would circumnavigate the 7+ acre pond that is in place now; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council Case #5.06, adopted February 13, 2024, the City Council approved plans and specifications and authorized advertising bids for Improvement Project #24-54; The Waterfront Trail Improvements; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council Resolution #24-131, adopted May 14, 2024, a budget was approved for The Waterfront of \$345,759 for the park, including the contract awarded to Kurilla Contracting of Buffalo, Minnesota, in the amount of \$169,165.00 for said trail improvements plus alternate bid in amount of \$22,250; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ramsey City Council Resolution #24-287 adopted October 22, 2024, Change Order #1 in the amount of \$12,750.00 to cover purchase of 10 ton of Boulders, Granite chips and Berm Earthwork to finish the project.

WHEREAS, as of January 10, 2026 \$180,967.45 has been paid to date; and

WHEREAS, the Senior Engineering Technician has inspected the completed work and recommends final payment to Kurilla Contracting of Buffalo, Minnesota, for said project, in the amount of \$ 1,827.95.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, as follows:

- 1) The City Council hereby authorizes final payment to Kurilla Contracting of Buffalo, Minnesota for Improvement Project #24-54, The Waterfront Trail Improvements, in the amount of \$1,827.95.
- 2) The City Council hereby accepts the project and authorizes the Mayor and City Administrator to sign the release form for this payment.
- 3) The total amount of this payment is not included in resolutions approving payment of bills for the date of February 10, 2026.
- 4) The City of Ramsey Finance Department will be provided a signed copy of this resolution.
