## THESE ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR **FREE**

### Scrap Metal

All non-metal parts and fluids **must be removed**

Used Oil, Oil Filters, and Antifreeze - *dispose of empty containers at home*

### Standard Curbside Recyclable Materials

Food/Beverage Glass, Aluminum/Steel Cans, Newspaper/Magazines/Cardboard, Plastic Bottles, Tubs/Lids (≤1 gallon)

### Bikes

Laptops, CPUs (towers), Tablets, Cell Phones

## PLEASE NOTE

- Some roads may be temporarily closed for traffic control during the event. Refer to the map on page 2 for site directions.
- Please be patient if the lines are long.
- Please load your vehicle so materials can be unloaded in the following order:
  - 1 Used oil, filters, antifreeze
  - 2 Bikes
  - 3 Scrap metal and curbside recyclables
  - 4 Mattresses/box springs
  - 5 Tires
  - 6 Bulbs and batteries
  - 7 Appliances
  - 8 Electronics
  - 9 Paper shredding

## **FREE** - Document Destruction/Paper Shredding

All types of paper accepted, no need to remove staples, paper clips, or rubber bands! No 3-ring binders. Limit of 3 boxes (equivalent to 12" x 12" x 24") *per household.*

# FREE Organics Recycling

If you would like to recycle organics without a fee, Ramsey still offers an organics recycling drop-off program. Sign up for the program by visiting [www.cityoframsey.com/578](http://www.cityoframsey.com/578). Food scraps can be up to 30 percent of what we throw away. You could save money on your trash bill by downsizing your garbage can.

## What Goes in the Organics Bin...

- Fruit and vegetable scraps
- Bread, pasta, and cereal
- Dairy and egg scraps
- Meat and fish scraps (including bones)
- Coffee grounds and filters
- Wooden Popsicle sticks and toothpicks
- Pizza delivery boxes
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper towels, napkins, and tissues
- Biodegradable Products Institute (BPI) certified paper plates, cups, and utensils
- Houseplant trimmings

Organics recycling kits are available for pick up at the Ramsey Municipal Center, Planning Division, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Included in your free kit are:

- One 5-gallon bucket with lid
- One roll of 13-gallon compostable bags
- One 3-gallon kitchen food scraps pail
- One roll of 2.5-gallon compostable bags
- An information sheet detailing what is accepted

## What Does Not Go in the Bin...

- Metal
- Plastic
- Glass
- Styrofoam™
- Pet droppings
- Twist ties
- Stickers on produce or other products
- Microwave popcorn bags
- Dryer lint
- K-cups
- Grease or oil
- Aluminum foil
- Diapers
- Yard waste



## MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED

- Garbage of any kind
- Yard and tree waste
- Window/door glass panes
- Furniture (except mattresses/box springs)
- Plastic containers > 1 gal.
- Construction debris, paint or other household hazardous waste materials identified by staff.
