<b>Unsupervised Probationers</b>			
Change in the State Law, the Court can no longer charge monthly administrative fees	Unsupervised probationers  Administration Fee	1 time per case  (change was monthly)	\$50.00 1 time per case  (Change from \$10.00 monthly)
To clarify that the fee is for unsupervised probation and that it is the responsibility of the Court Compliance Officer to do the verification of completion.	Unsupervised Probationers  For the cost of verifying the completion of the conditions of probation	1 time per case	\$20.00  (No change in the fee amount)
<b>Supervised Probationers</b>			
Change in the State Law requiring (for those who can pay) a minimum charge of \$65.00 for monitoring fees. The State Law still gives the Court discretion to impose a lesser fee or even no fee for probationers who are unable to pay.	Supervised Probationers  Monitoring Fee	Monthly	\$65.00  (Change from \$15.00)
Need to have a realistic charge to cover actual costs of drug testing	Drug testing when part of the probationer's conditions	1 time per case	\$50.00  (Change from \$5.00)
