A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA TO RECEIVE FUNDING FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF POLICE RADIOS BY APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE SUBGRANTEE AGREEMENT-REALLOCATION BETWEEN THE STATE OF ARIZONA THROUGH THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA THROUGH THE SAN LUIS POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis desires to replace inoperable Police Department radios to strengthen police communication capabilities;

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Homeland Security has awarded reimbursement funds to replace Police Department radios; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Homeland Security has prepared an Intergovernmental Agreement which provides for all the conditions of acceptance of the funds including that these funds shall not be used to supplant other funding of the San Luis Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, State of Arizona as follows:

Section 1: That the Intergovernmental Agreement titled "SUBGRANTEE AGREEMENT-REALLOCATION 14-AZDOHS-HSGP-140430-03 Between The Arizona Department of Homeland Security And San Luis Police Department" [sic] and the grant application titled "FY15 Interoperability Replacement Program" both attached to this resolution is approved.

Section 2: That the appropriate City officials are hereby authorized and directed to enter into said agreement on behalf of the City and take any and all actions as may be necessary to effectuate said agreement.
