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Pursuant to the Constitution of Arizona, Article VI, the Supreme Court has administrative supervision over all courts of the state through its Administrative Office of the Courts.

It has come to the Court's attention that the San Luis Municipal Court is without a Presiding Magistrate.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the San Luis Municipal Court shall be assumed by the Honorable Maria Elena Cruz, Presiding Judge, Superior Court in Yuma County, and Judge Cruz shall assign judges as needed to conduct court business.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall remain in effect until a successor assumes duties of the office.
