AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA BY ADDING CHAPTER 153 TO TITLE XV, PUBLIC WORKS STANDARDS, REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona as follows:

Section 1: That certain documents known as “Public Works Standards for Yuma County Volume 3” as adopted by Yuma County on August 21, 2006, “Construction Standard Detail Drawings, February 2009 of the City of Yuma”, “Uniform Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction as sponsored and distributed by the Maricopa Association of Governments 2015 Edition” and “City of San Luis Supplement to the 2015 MAG Uniform Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction and to the City of Yuma Construction Standard Detail Drawings”, three copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk, of the City of San Luis, Arizona, said documents having been made a public record by Resolution No. 1166 of the City of San Luis, Arizona are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof as the Public Works Standards of the City of San Luis as though fully set forth again in full.

Section 2: The Public Works Standards of the City of San Luis shall be Chapter 153 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of San Luis.

Section 3: In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Ordinance and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 5: Whereas, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of San Luis, Arizona the Public Works Standards be adopted so that the infrastructure of the city of San Luis may be constructed properly and for the further reason that the best interests of the City require the provisions of this ordinance to go into immediate effect, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become immediately operative and in force and effect from and after the date of posting hereof.
