WHEREAS each dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that I, Gerardo Sanchez, Mayor of the City of San Luis Arizona do hereby proclaim the week of April 10 through 16, 2016 to be National Public-Safety Telecommunications Week in San Luis, Arizona, in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our city and citizens safe.
