A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA APPROVING THE ADDENDUM TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AND YUMA COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING MANDATORY WEEKEND AND HOLIDAY COURT SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis desires to exercise the option to extend a previous Intergovernmental Agreement with Yuma County for the provision of mandatory weekend and holiday court services; and

WHEREAS, all parties to the Intergovernmental Agreement desire to exercise the option to extend said agreement;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, State of Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: That the addendum to the intergovernmental agreement, as attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is hereby approved.

Section 2: That the appropriate City officials are hereby authorized and directed to enter into said agreement on behalf of the City and take any all actions as may be necessary to effectuate said agreement.

ADDENDUM TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
YUMA COUNTY AND CITY OF SAN LUIS
FOR
Weekend and Holiday Municipal Court Coverage

Pursuant to number 2, TERM: of the original intergovernmental agreement dated July 1, 2016 and recorded with the Yuma County Recorder for the provision of weekend and holiday Municipal Court coverage, it is hereby agreed upon by the parties to exercise the option to extend said agreement for an additional one year period beginning July 1, 2017 and terminating on June 30, 2018. The City shall pay the County \$1,159.00 for the period covered under the original intergovernmental agreement July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017. All of the terms and conditions contained in the original intergovernmental agreement remain in full force and effect during the extended term.
