**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FOR FY 2017 STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT STATE SPECIAL PROJECT FUNDS (CDBG-SSP), CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATION MEETS THE COMMUNITY'S PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATION.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Luis, Arizona, is desirous of undertaking community development activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Arizona is administering the Community Development Block Grant State Special Project Program (CDBG-SSP); and

**WHEREAS**, the State CDBG-SSP Program requires that CDBG funds requested address one of three Congressionally mandated National Objectives; and

**WHEREAS**, the activities within the application address the community's identified housing and community development needs, including the needs of low and moderate income persons; and

**WHEREAS**, an Applicant for State CDBG-SSP funds is required to comply with the program guidelines and Federal Statutes and regulations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, County of Yuma authorize application to be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Housing for FY 2017 CDBG-SSP funds, and authorize the Mayor to sign application and contract or grant documents for receipt and use of these funds for "International Plaza I Improvements"; and authorize the Mayor to take all actions necessary to implement and complete the activities submitted in said application; and

**THAT** the application for State CDBG-SSP funds meets the requirements of low- and moderate-income benefit for activities justified as benefitting low- and moderate-income persons, aids in the prevention or elimination of slum and blight, or addresses an urgent need which poses a threat to health; and

**THAT** the City of San Luis, Arizona will comply with all State CDBG-SSP Program Guidelines, Federal Statutes and regulations applicable to the State CDBG-SSP Program and the certifications contained in the application.
