ORDER INCORPORATING THE TOWN OF
SAN LUIS

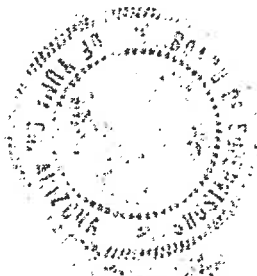
Petitions purporting to contain the signatures of more than two-thirds of the qualified electors residing in the community known as San Luis, Arizona, requesting the incorporation thereof, according to boundaries contained in a description filed simultaneously with said petitions, having been filed with the Board of Supervisors of Yuma County, Arizona, and the Board of Supervisors being fully satisfied that at least two-thirds of the qualified electors residing in the town of San Luis, Yuma County, Arizona, within the area hereinafter more particularly described by metes and bounds have signed the petitions presented to this Board as aforesaid requesting incorporation and that the said area hereinafter described contains more than one thousand five hundred inhabitants, and that the petition as filed complies with the provisions of Chapter 1, Article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S. Section 9-101);

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the town of San Luis be, and the same hereby is, incorporated as a town under the provisions of the Arizona Revised Statutes relating to the incorporation of towns under Common Council Government; that its corporate name shall be and is the town of "San Luis", and that from and after this date the inhabitants within the area defined herein shall be a body politic and corporate and a political subdivision of the State of Arizona under the name heretofore designated.

The metes and bounds description of said town of San Luis and the area hereby incorporated as such is as follows:

Beginning at a point in section 12, T11S, R25W, G & S R B & M, Yuma County, Arizona, said point being the intersection of the west line of U.S. Highway No. 95 and the International Boundary between the United States and the Republic of Mexico; thence north along the west line of U. S. Highway No. 95, to the south line of "A" Street as shown on Plat of San Luis Townsite, Addition No. 1; thence west along the south line of "A" Street and the westerly prolongation thereof, to a point on the southerly prolongation of the east line of the East Main Canal; thence northerly along the east line of the East Main Canal, to a point on the south line of the north 33.0 feet of said section 12; thence west along the south line of the north 33.0 feet of section 12, to the east line of sec. 11, T11S, R25W, thence west along the south line of the north 33.0 feet of sec. 11, to an intersection with the southerly prolongation of the east line of Escondido Beach Subdivision; thence northwesterly along the west line of Avenue "J" as shown on Escondido Beach Subdivision and the northerly prolongation thereof, to the west line of U.S. Highway No. 95; thence north along the west line of U.S. Highway No. 95, to an intersection with the westerly prolongation of the north line of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 1, T11S, R25W, G & S R B & M, thence east to the N.E. corner of said SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 1; thence south along the east line of said SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 1, to the south line of the East Main Canal; thence northeasterly along the south line of the East Main Canal, to the east line of the W 1/2 of said Sec. 1; thence South along said East line and the southerly prolongation thereof, to the International Boundary line between the United States and the Republic of Mexico; thence northwesterly along said International Boundary Line, to the point of beginning.
