Kay,

As you know we have recently been getting a lot of interest from ICE to increase the amount of beds they use at the detention center. Some time last year we talked to their administration in DC asking if they were willing to guarantee a minimum population to be housed at the unit for a period of at least five years. At that time they were not ready to commit to that and asked if we could set aside 200-250 for their use. We told them we would do our best and continued to serve the Marshals and ICE together balancing the beds between the two agencies with Marshals using about 500-550 and ICE using 200-250 on average.

Well now ICE has come back asking if the offer to guarantee beds is still on the table if you read below. If we were to commit to ICE it would mean that we could continue to serve US Marshals in AZ (150) but that Marshals CA would have to reduce their population. Up to this point the Marshals have been our strongest client but they have not committed to a minimum guarantee. I reached out to Aisha and asked for the USMS contact in the CA region to see if they would be willing to guarantee beds and gather all our options before we present our recommendation to you all. I wanted you to know that this was taking place and I am working with David to be sure we have covered all our bases.
