GENERAL ELECTION 2020
PROPOSITION 207

WHEREAS, the returns for the General Election held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November 2020, have been canvassed and certified on the 30th day of November 2020, in accordance with Article IV, Part 1, Section 1, of the Constitution of the State of Arizona, Sections 16-648 and 19-126 of the Arizona Revised Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 207 is an amendment to the Arizona Revised Statutes referred by the Initiative to a vote of the qualified electors; and

WHEREAS, the whole number of votes cast for and against Proposition 207 was as follows:

PROPOSITION 207: Amending Section 36-2817, Arizona Revised Statutes; amending Title 36, Arizona Revised Statutes, by adding Chapter 28.2; amending Title 42, Chapter 5, Arizona Revised Statutes, by adding Article 10; amending Title 43, Chapter 1, Article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes, by adding Section 43-108; relating to the responsible adult use, regulation and taxation of marijuana.
