**WHEREAS**, Public Safety Telecommunicators of the City of San Luis Police Department have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients; and

**WHEREAS**, each dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that, I, Gerardo Sanchez, Mayor of the City of San Luis Arizona do hereby proclaim the week of April 11 through 17, 2021 to be National Public-Safety Telecommunicators Week in San Luis, Arizona, in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our city and citizens safe.
