A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS FOR FY 2021 STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS AND FY 2021 STATE SPECIAL PROJECT FUNDS (CDBG-SSP), CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATIONS MEET THE COMMUNITY'S PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATIONS; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, Arizona, is desirous of undertaking community development activities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is administering the Community Development Block Grant/State Special Project Programs (CDBG-CDBG-SSP); and

WHEREAS, the State CDBG/CDBG-SSP Programs require that CDBG funds requested address one of three Congressionally mandated National Objectives; and

WHEREAS, the activities within the applications address the community's identified housing and community development needs, including the needs of moderate-and low-income persons; and

WHEREAS, an Applicant for State CDBG/CDBG SSP funds is required to comply with the program guidelines and Federal Statutes and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, County of Yuma:

Section 1. The City Council authorizes applications to be made to the State of Arizona Department of Housing for FY 2021 CDBG funds and FY 2021 CDBG-SSP funds, and authorizes the Mayor to sign applications, contract or grant documents for receipt of and use of these funds for "Mesa Street Improvements Project, Rancho Los Oros Phase 2 Improvements and Rancho Los Oros Improvements Phase 3 (alternate application)"; and

authorizes the Mayor to take all actions necessary to implement and complete the activities submitted in said applications;

Section 2. The applications for State CDBG/CDBG-SSP funds meet the requirements for low and moderate-income benefit activities, aids in the prevention or elimination of slum and blight, or addresses an urgent need which poses a threat to health; and

Section 3. The City of San Luis, Arizona will comply with all State CDBG/CDBG-SSP Program Guidelines, Federal Statutes and regulations applicable to the State CDBG/CDBG-SSP Program and the certifications contained in the applications.

Section 4. Conflicting Provisions: in the event of a conflict between provisions of this resolution and any other resolution, order, regulation or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are repealed, superseded and replaced, and the provisions of this resolution shall govern.

Section 3. Severability: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance
