In 2020 we had high hopes of spaying and neutering more animals from your community than years prior. I am happy to say that 44 animals from your community were altered last year through our clinic with different grants. With COVID, it was a little difficult to get more done or do a campaign in your community about spaying and neutering of pets.

Therefore, HSOY is once again requesting \$5,000, in addition to our current contract amount, to go towards spaying and neutering animals within your community. The money would only be going to people who show proof of residence within the City of San Luis, AZ. As your citizens call HSOY to schedule an appointment, they would state that they live within your City and we would schedule them.

HSOY will continue to serve your community in any way possible. From low cost vaccinations to low cost/free microchipping, we are committed to helping the stray animal population in your community decrease. The spaying/neutering component continues to be the single most important component to being a good pet parent.
