The Arizona Interagency Farmworkers Coalition, Inc. (AIFC) is a non-profit organization whose primary focus is to increase awareness and coordinate efforts around available resources and programs for migrant and seasonal agricultural workers in the state of Arizona. Our working Board of Directors includes representatives from such diverse areas as Education, Health, Labor, and other community based organizations.

AIFC's main activity is our annual educational conference and scholarship award ceremony. Each year, AIFC awards between five and 20 scholarships ranging in amounts from \$500 to \$3,000, to students from families that earn a living as migrant or seasonal agricultural workers. The AIFC conference is the only one of its kind in Arizona that provides opportunities to build collaborative relationships across agencies and disciplines to provide the most relevant, useful, and updated information for those that work with the people that put food on all of our tables.
