**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS ADOPTING CONFLICT OF INTEREST PROCEDURES TO SUPPLEMENT THE CITY OF SAN LUIS PERSONNEL POLICIES; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.**

**WHEREAS**, Section HR-5-01, C 7 of the City of San Luis Personnel Policies provides for a standard of conduct concerning conflicts of interest; and

**WHEREAS**, said section lacks the detail that would provide more direction.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** based on the foregoing and by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona:

**Section 1:** The Mayor and City Council have determined that it is in the City's best interest to provide further guidance on conflict of interest.

**Section 2:** The City of San Luis Personnel Policies are hereby supplemented with the document titled, "City of San Luis Conflict of Interest Procedures" which incorporated into this resolution by this reference.

**Section 3:** In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this resolution and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced; and the provisions of this resolution shall govern.

**Section 4:** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.
