

## No. 21XX

A resolution of the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, setting the Border Area Vehicle Permit Fee; repealing any conflicting provisions; providing for severability; establishing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

**WHEREAS**, on December 22, 2020, City Council passed the fee for the permit at \$24.00;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

**Section 1.** The fee for each border area taxi vehicle permit under City Code § 112.09 is \$24.00 per calendar year.

**Section 2.** The 2020 \$50.00 fee paid under Ordinances 393 and 394 shall be extended through the end of 2021 for the 35 vehicles that were permitted in 2020.

**Section 3.** A transportation business holding permits from 2020 may substitute vehicles within their business for a 2021 permit under the extension. However, any vehicles that exceed the number of vehicles the transportation business had permits for in 2020 shall pay a \$24.00 fee for 2021 for the excess number of vehicles.

**Section 4.** In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this ordinance and any other ordinance, resolution, order, regulation, or policy of the city, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

**Section 5.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

**Section 6.** Whereas, to preserve the peace in the city's competitive taxicab economy and under city codes § 110.05 and § 112.09(G), the taxi vehicle permits expired on December 31, 2020. The 2021 permit fee is due before January 31, 2021; the new lower fee must be passed in less than 30 days, allowed under A.R.S. § 19-142 as an emergency measure.

**Section 7.** Whereas, it is necessary to preserve the peace, health and safety of the City, Arizona, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become immediately operative and in force from and after the date of the posting of this ordinance.
