

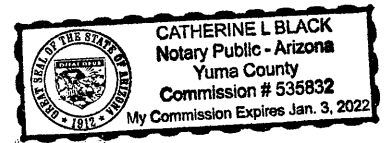

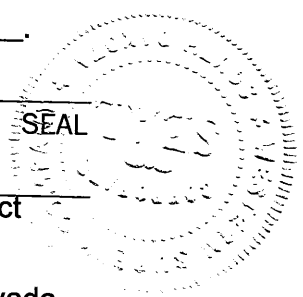

CONTRACT AND BONDS: Upon receipt of written notice that this bid has been accepted, the undersigned will execute a formal Contract, sample of which is appended, hereafter as Document 00400 and will deliver a one hundred percent Statutory Payment Bond (Document 00520) to the Owner.

BID SURETY: The attached Bid Security Bond (Document 00350) in the sum of not less than ten percent (10%) of the total maximum bid price will be retained by the Owner if the Contract and Bonds are not executed as specified in the Instruction to Bidders (Document 00030).

The undersigned understands that any quantities stated or implied in the Project Plans or Manual are approximate only and are subject to increase or decrease, and hereby proposes to perform all quantities of Work either increased or decreased, in accordance with the provisions of the Project Manual, at the Unit Bid Price in the Bid Form. Construction items called out in the plans, but not list as quantities are to be considered incidental to the other project pay items. After the bid opening the Engineer employees will check the math on each proposal and all other documents before selecting a successful bidder based on the Unit Bid Prices turned in on the Bid Forms and the appropriate signed and executed documents. This task may take more than one day to complete.
