A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL, DESIGNATING THE CHIEF FISCAL OFFICER FOR OFFICIALLY SUBMITTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 EXPENDITURE LIMITATION REPORT TO THE ARIZONA AUDITOR GENERAL; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §41-1279.07(E) requires each county, city, town, and community college district to annually provide to the Arizona Auditor General by July 31 the name of the Chief Fiscal Officer the governing body designated to officially submit the current year's annual expenditure limitation report ("AELR") on the governing body's behalf; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis Mayor and Council desire to designate Monica Castro as the City's Chief Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, Entities must submit an updated form and documentation for any changes in the individuals designated to file the AELR; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, the City Council intended and did allow the Chief Executive Officer Monica Castro to file the AELR and now desires to ratify that action.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SAN LUIS MAYOR AND COUNCIL as follows:

Section 1: The recitals above are hereby incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: Monica Castro is hereby ratified and designated as the City's Chief Fiscal Officer for purposes of submitting the fiscal year 2020-2021 AELR to the Arizona Auditor General on the governing body's behalf, and the filing is ratified.

Section 3: WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City, an emergency is declared to exist, and this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
