AN ORDER OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, COMMENCING A FIVE-DAY WORKWEEK FOR EMPLOYEES ON A FOUR-DAY WORKWEEK; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

IT IS ORDERED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona:

Section 1. *Order* shall mean this Order No. 2022-13.

Section 2. *City* shall mean the Arizona municipal corporation of San Luis.

Section 3 Those City employees who work a four-day workweek at ten regular hours per workday shall start on Tuesday, January 3, 2023, to work a five-day workweek at eight regular hours per workday, except the work schedule shall not change for those employees in Public Safety (the Police and Fire Departments) who work a four-day workweek at ten regular hours per workday.

Section 4. In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Order and any other City order, resolution, regulation, or policy, the conflicting provisions are repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this Order shall govern.

Section 5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Order is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction or operation of legislation, such decision or legislation shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Order.
