**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AMENDING SECTION 2.05.400 OF THE CITY CODE TO CHANGE THE START TIME OF REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS TO 6:00 P.M.; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona:

**Section 1:** Section 2.05.400 of the San Luis City Code is amended to read:

The Council shall hold regular meetings on the second and fourth Wednesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. If the day fixed for a regular meeting of the Council falls upon a day designated by law as a legal holiday, then the Mayor (or the Vice Mayor in the Mayor's absence) shall set a date for the meeting that is not a legal holiday. All regular meetings of the Council shall be held in Council Chambers at City Hall.

**Section 2:** In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this ordinance and any other ordinance, order, resolution, regulation, or policy, the conflicting provisions are repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

**Section 3:** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction or operation of legislation, such decision or legislation shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
