

10.15.235 Parking in alleys.

(A) No person shall park a vehicle within an alley in a manner or under conditions as to leave available less than ten feet of the width of the roadway for the free movement of vehicular traffic, and no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle within an alley in a position as to block the driveway entrance to any abutting property.

(B) No person shall park any vehicle in any alley, except commercial cars, trucks or wagons for the purpose of loading and unloading, then not for a period longer than is actually necessary to load or unload. Vehicles displaying state disabled parking identifying insignia may stand or park in an alley while loading or unloading persons for a period not to exceed five minutes.

(C) At no time shall a vehicle parked in an alley be left unattended during the time of loading and unloading. (Ord. 189 § 1, passed 8-11-2004. Code 1982 § 10-3-8. Code 2012 § 72.27.)
