A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE ENTERING INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE BUREAU OF RECLAMATION (“B.O.R”) FOR UNIFORM LICENCE AGREEMENT PERMITTING CONSTRUCTION, INSTALLATION, OWNERSHIP, USE, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF COUNTY 24TH STREET IN THE CITY OF SAN LUIS UNDER B.O.R. CONTRACT NO. 22-07-34-L2106.

WHEREAS the City of San Luis submitted a transportation and utility systems and facilities federal land application to the Bureau of Reclamation; and

WHEREAS the City requires right of way in order to construct County 24th Street; and

WHEREAS the Bureau of Reclamation requires state or local governments to provide authorization to execute the license;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Council deem that it is in the best interest of the City of San Luis’ residents to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the United States of America through the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation to permit the city to construct County 24th Street.

Section 2. A true copy of the intergovernmental agreement (B.O.R Contract No. 22-07-34-L2106) is incorporated herein as though set forth again in full.

Section 3. The Mayor is authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the City of San Luis.

Section 4. City officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this Order.
