2024 Legislative Session

- Second Regular Session of the 56th Arizona Legislature
 - Convened on Monday, January 8, 2024
- Republican Majority
 - Senate: 16 Republicans, 14 Democrats
 - House: 31 Republicans, 29 Democrats
- San Luis' Legislative District – 23rd
 - Senate: 1 Democrat
 - House: 1 Democrat and 1 Republican

Legislative Outreach

- Meet with Legislators over the session
- Plan and organize the council's interaction and relationship-building
- Conceptualize and present how legislation affects City of San Luis
- Legislative Visit: March 2023 (exact date TBD)

Major Themes

- FY 2024 Budget Shortfall
- FY 2025 Budget
- Land Use Planning
- Affordable Housing
- Homelessness

Legislative Priorities

Fiscal Sustainability

- Protection of state-shared revenue
- Full funding of existing revenue streams
- Preservation of local taxing authority
- Oppose unfunded mandates

Economic Development

- Local authority to execute economic development projects
- Maintain and enhance current economic development tools

Legislative Priorities

Land Use Planning

- Maintain local authority

Neighborhoods

- Preserve and enhance the quality of life in neighborhoods

Public Safety

- Preserve and enhance the ability to strategically plan for and respond to emergencies

Transportation

- Encourage additional tools to provide for transportation improvements

Water

- Ensure the wise use of natural resources
