**AN ORDER OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, OPTING FOR DISBURSEMENTS OF ALL PRESENT AND FUTURE SETTLEMENT FUNDS FROM YUMA COUNTY FROM SETTLEMENT MONEY IN THE CASE TITLED, IN RE NATIONAL PRESCRIPTION OPIATE LITIGATION; REPEALING CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Luis is a plaintiff in the In re: National Prescription Opiate Litigation, Multi-District Litigation Case No. 2804 (Northern Federal District of Ohio) ("Opiate Litigation") through Order No. 2019-10; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Luis adopted the One Arizona Distribution of Opioid Settlement Funds Agreement through Order No. 2021-10; and

**WHEREAS**, defendants Mallinckrodt and Janssen in the Opiate Litigation have settled; and

**WHEREAS**, settlement funds for the City of San Luis, Arizona are available through Yuma County, Arizona; and

**WHEREAS**, as more defendants settle or are ordered to pay, the money allocated for San Luis will continue to be deposited with Yuma County;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona;

**Section 1**: The City of San Luis, Arizona opts for Yuma County, Arizona, to disburse all Opiate Litigation funds allocated for the City of San Luis, Arizona, currently available and as more becomes available.

**Section 2**: If a conflict arises between the provisions of this Order and any other ordinance, resolution, order, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are amended, superseded, and replaced, and this Order shall govern.

**Section 3**: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence clause, phrase, or portion of this Order is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of

competent jurisdiction or operation of law by binding legislation, such decision or legislation shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Order.

**Section 4:** City staff shall do and perform, or cause to be done and performed, all such further acts and shall execute and deliver all documents as may be necessary to carry out the intent and accomplish the purposes of this Order.
