AN ORDER OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING JOINING THE SETTLING STATES, THE PARTICIPATING SUBDIVISIONS, AND KROGER IN A PROPOSED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT RESOLVING LEGAL CLAIMS AGAINST KROGER FOR ALLEGED MISCONDUCT RELATED TO OPIOIDS.

WHEREAS, the San Luis City Council understands that Kroger Co. (the supermarket pharmacy) has proposed a settlement agreement to resolve claims against it for alleged misconduct related to opioids; and

WHEREAS, the Kroger proposed settlement is separate from the resolution of the In re: National Prescription Opiate Litigation Multi-District Litigation Case No. 2804 (ND Ohio) that the City of San Luis opted to join in November of 2019; and

WHEREAS, participants in the Kroger proposed settlement through the same court case must opt in before August 12, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the San Luis City Council finds it in the public interest for the city to join the settlement for the benefits toward abating the opioid crisis the settlement affords;

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona:

Section 1: The above-recited understanding and findings of the San Luis City Council are incorporated by this reference and made a part of this order.

Section 2: The Mayor is authorized to sign the opt-in form to join the Kroger Co. settlement.

Section 3: The City Manager and City Attorney or their designees are authorized to take such action as necessary to opt-in to join the Kroger Co. settlement.
